WELCOME TO ESSEX YACHT CLUB

On behalf of the membership, the Flag Officers welcome you and your crew to the Essex Yacht Club. We hope your stay is enjoyable.

This brochure will acquaint you with our facility, waterfront and house rules, and various services.

Upon your first visit ashore, we ask that all persons aboard sign the guest book located inside the main entrance of the club. With over 400 yachts requesting the use of our facility each summer, we ask your cooperation in observing our house rules and helping us to maintain our facility in first class condition. The Club Manager and staff stand ready to assist you and answer any questions you may have.

Club privileges are extended to guests of EYC members and all yachtsmen in good standing with recognized yacht clubs for a period of up to two weeks unless otherwise requested and approved by a flag officer.

HOUSE RULES

- As a courtesy to members and guests, cell phones may not be used for telephone conversations in the Clubhouse or on the deck or patios.
- Proper attire is required on the club premises. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times.
- Smoking is not permitted in any part of the Clubhouse or on the deck or patios.
- Children under the age of twelve must be accompanied by a parent or guardian while on the premises and must wear a life preserver while on Club docks, bulkheads, floats and launches.
- Dogs must be leashed and are not allowed in the Clubhouse. Owners must clean up after their dog.

SLIPS, DOCKAGE AND MOORINGS

■ Slips, moorings and dockage are available to visitors at the discretion of the Club Manager. "Check-out" time is 1100 hours.

■ Fees for slips, moorings and launch service are payable upon arrival. The club does not bill other clubs.

Moorings: \$50 daily
(50 foot LOA max in mooring field)

Slips & Dockage: \$3.75 per foot daily
(Rate includes water and either one 50-ampere service or two 30-ampere services. Additional electricity is available for \$10 a day per connection)

- The outer fixed docks are available for loading and unloading with a 30 minute time limit.
- The use of slips, dockage and moorings is at your own risk. Essex Yacht Club assumes no liability for the use of Club facilities.
- No open fires on property or docks.

■ ICE

Available from launch staff.

■ WATER

Available at outer fixed dock.

■ TRASH

Receptacles in back parking lot. Recycling is a must.

■ SHOWERS

Available during hours the clubhouse is open. Located in bathrooms on first floor of the clubhouse.

■ FUEL

Available at Brewer's Dauntless Marina and Essex Island Marina, both just north of EYC.

■ PUMP-OUT

Available at Brewer's Dauntless Marina just north of EYC. There is also a lower Connecticut River pump-out boat that serves Essex from Memorial Day to October. The service is free and the boat can be hailed on VHF Channel 72.

EMERGENCY
